LB 996 amends Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 4-114 regarding the electronic verification of work eligibility through the E-Verify Program.

The bill would change the verification requirements for employees performing work pursuant to a public contract in the State of Nebraska to apply to all employees rather than just new or newly hired employees.

The bill also adds new language defining "public contract."

COUNTIES – No basis to disagree with estimate of impact.

The Department of Administrative Services indicates the bill appears to have no fiscal impact.

The University of Nebraska indicates the bill could require contractors to do more in terms of verification and those costs could be passed on to the University but they are unable to determine the fiscal impact.

The bill appears to have no fiscal impact to State revenue or expenditures.

IMPACT TO POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS:

The Nebraska Association of County Officials indicates that LB 996, as drafted, appears to have no measurable fiscal impact to counties.
