Dear Chairman Hansen:

This letter is to address the question of how Temporary Certified Nurse Midwives are regulated in other states.

In Nebraska, this profession is regulated under the Advance Practiced Registered Nurse (APRN) Practice Act. However, Nebraska is the only state with a board specifically for APRN licensure. In other states, most APRNs are governed through a Board of Nursing, i.e. the same board that governs Registered Nurse (RN) licensure in the state. Nurse midwives in some states are regulated through a Board of Midwifery. Information on nursing regulation in other states, territories, and countries can be found at www.ncsbn.org.
