POLITICAL PARTIES

By law, partisan and nonpartisan candidates for elective offices in Nebraska are nominated by primary election or by petition. Each party's convention is held biennially after the primary election at a date set by the state central committee, but not later than Oct. 1. The convention determines the party's state platform, selects a state central committee, nominates candidates for elective offices excepted from the operation of the direct primary law, and selects candidates for electors for president and vice president of the United States.

ELECTIONS

Statewide primary elections in Nebraska are held on the first Tuesday after the second Monday in May in even-numbered years.

Any citizen of the United States may vote in a Nebraska primary or general election, provided that he or she:

- is at least 18 years old. According to the state constitution, individuals may vote in any election held during the calendar year of their 18th birthday, provided they reach the age of 18 on or before the general election.

- has registered to vote in his or her county of residence by the second Friday before the election

- has never been convicted of treason or felony under the laws of Nebraska or the United States

This section includes Nebraska presidential election returns from 1868 to 2016 and election returns from Nebraska's 2018 primary and general elections as certified by the Board of State Canvassers and the Legislature.

An initiative measure to enact a statute to impose a 20% annual tax on gross gaming revenue from games of chance operated at licensed racetrack locations; distribute 75% of such gaming tax revenues to the state for credit of 2.5% to both the Compulsive Gamblers Assistance Fund and General Fund and 70% to the Property Tax Credit Cash Fund; and distribute 25% of such gaming tax revenues to the county where the licensed racetrack is located, or, if the racetrack is located partially within a city or village, distribute this percentage evenly between the county and city or village.
