LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 26CA
 PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

1 THE MEMBERS OF THE SIXTEENTH LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

2 Section 1. At the general election in November 2016 the following proposed amendment
 3 to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska for
 4 approval or rejection:

5 To amend Article III, section 8, Article IV, section 2, and Article V, section 7:

6 A No person is shall be eligible for to the office of member of the Legislature if, unless
 7 on the date of the general election at which such person he is elected; or on the date of his or
 8 her appointment, such person he is a registered voter, has attained the federal voting age, of
 9 twenty-one years and has resided within the district from which he or she is elected or
 10 appointed for the term of one year next before his or her election or appointment unless such
 11 person has, unless he shall have been absent on the public business of the United States or of
 12 this State. A And no person elected or appointed to the office of member of the Legislature as
 13 aforesaid shall not hold such his office after he or she has shall have removed from such
 14 district.

15 A person shall be eligible to any public office, whether elected or appointed, if such
 16 person has attained the federal voting age, subject to qualifications other than age,
 17 established by law. A No person shall be eligible to the office of Governor, or Lieutenant
 18 Governor if he or she has, who shall not have attained the age of thirty years, and who shall
 1 not have been for five years next preceding his or her election a resident and citizen of this

2 state and a citizen of the United States. ~~Any~~ ~~None of the~~ appointive officers mentioned in this
3 article shall not be eligible to any other state office during the period for which they have
4 been appointed.

5 A person shall be eligible to any public office, whether elected or appointed, if such
6 person has attained the federal voting age, subject to qualifications other than age,
7 established by law. ~~A~~ ~~No~~ person shall be eligible to the office of Chief Justice or Judge of the
8 Supreme Court if such person is ~~unless he shall be at least thirty years of age,~~ and a citizen of
9 the United States; and has ~~shall have~~ resided in this state at least three years next preceding
10 his or her selection; and ~~nor~~, in the case of a Judge of the Supreme Court selected from a
11 Supreme Court judicial district, if ~~unless he~~ or she is ~~shall be~~ a resident and elector of the
12 district from which selected.

13 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors in the manner
14 prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI, section 1, with the following
15 ballot language:

16 A constitutional amendment to provide and change eligibility requirements for public
17 office.
