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DISTRICTS AT-A-GLANCE

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
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This first edition of Districts At-a-Glance ranks Nebraska legislative districts in a variety of metrics – from economics to health to education. While past publications in our “At-a-Glance” series focused on state-by-state comparisons and county-level analysis, Districts At-a-Glance focuses exclusively on ranking legislative districts. It is a statistical snapshot of Nebraska, designed to give policymakers and the public a glimpse of the challenges and opportunities facing different districts across the state. All of the data in this report comes from the Census Bureau’s American Community Survey (ACS), which was conducted over five years, from 2010 to 2014. The ACS represents the gold standard in domestic demographic and statistical data.

METHODOLOGY




The tables, graphs, and maps in Districts-at-a-Glance use the most current data available for all 49 Legislative Districts. Districts are always ranked from highest to lowest value, without regard to subject matter, so a higher ranking is not always preferable to a lower ranking.

The rankings in this report were determined using multiple decimal places of precision. However, for the purposes of the tables on each page, values are rounded to a single decimal place. Thus, two districts can appear equal in their numerical measure, but still have different rankings.

Every ranking also includes a color-coded map and a bar graph comparing the highest and lowest ranked districts. Source information is located at the bottom of each page, including a link to the raw data. Text in each header includes supplemental information about the subject, including definitions, additional rankings, and more detailed data.

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


ESTIMATED DISTRICT POPULATION SIZE






ESTIMATED DISTRICT POPULATION SIZE



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
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
MEDIAN AGE

PERCENT OF POPULATION UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE






PERCENT OF POPULATION UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE



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
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

PERCENT OF POPULATION OVER 65 YEARS OF AGE






PERCENT OF POPULATION OVER 65 YEARS OF AGE



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
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
MINORITIES

PERCENT OF RESIDENTS THAT IDENTIFY AS "NON-WHITE"





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
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IMMIGRANT POPULATION

PERCENT OF RESIDENTS BORN OUTSIDE THE U.S.






PERCENT OF RESIDENTS BORN OUTSIDE THE U.S.



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
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


PERCENT OF RESIDENTS THAT SPEAK A LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH




PERCENT OF RESIDENTS THAT SPEAK A LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH






PERCENT OF RESIDENTS WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DEGREE






PERCENT OF RESIDENTS WITH A COLLEGE DEGREE








INCOME


MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME (DOLLARS)



MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME (DOLLARS)



The labor force participation rate is the percent of the population that is either working or actively seeking work. Unemployed individuals who are not looking for work are excluded.


PERCENT OF RESIDENTS EMPLOYED OR SEEKING WORK




PERCENT OF RESIDENTS EMPLOYED OR SEEKING WORK





This ranking measures the average percent of the civilian non-institutional labor force 16 years of age and older who were unemployed from 2010 to 2014.


AVERAGE 12-MONTH UNEMPLOYMENT RATE




AVERAGE 12-MONTH UNEMPLOYMENT RATE








HOMEOWNERSHIP


PERCENT OF HOMES OCCUPIED BY THE OWNER




PERCENT OF HOMES OCCUPIED BY THE OWNER




PERCENT OF FAMILIES BELOW THE POVERTY LINE


PERCENT OF POPULATION ENROLLED IN SNAP






PERCENT OF RESIDENTS WITH HEALTH INSURANCE






PERCENT OF POPULATION UNDER 18 WITH HEALTH INSURANCE






PERCENT OF RESIDENTS RECEIVING MEDICAID BENEFITS



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
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


PERCENT OF RESIDENTS RECEIVING MEDICARE BENEFITS




PERCENT OF RESIDENTS RECEIVING MEDICARE BENEFITS






PERCENT OF RESIDENTS RECEIVING SOCIAL SECURITY




PERCENT OF RESIDENTS RECEIVING SOCIAL SECURITY

PERCENT OF RESIDENTS WITH PRIOR MILITARY SERVICE




